

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF BASALT, COLORADO, DIRECTING  
STAFF TO FINALIZE AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT (IGA) WITH THE  
COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTION (CDOT) FOR A SEDIMENT  
REMOVAL PROGRAM ALONG THE ROARING FORK RIVER BENEATH THE  
UPPER BYPASS BRIDGE ON SH82.**

**RECITALS**

1. The Town of Basalt through various actions of the Town Council have been working to reduce the potential for flooding in the Southside area of Basalt.
2. Southside business have continually raised concerns about the cost of flood insurance and the need for the Town to make both floodway and floodplain improvements so that a new FEMA Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM) could be adopted.
3. The Town in looking at the various issues that contribute to the potential for Southside flooding has identified cobble(sediment) buildup underneath the Bypass Bridge on SH82 as a contributing factor.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Basalt Town Council of Basalt, Colorado, as follows:

1. The Town Manager and Town Engineer finalized an IGA with CDOT that addresses Sediment Removal underneath the Upper Bypass Bridget on SH82.
2. The Town Manager notify Southside businesses and residents of this IGA and the continued work of the Town in removing flooding potentials in the Southside area.
