**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF BASALT, COLORADO,
SUPPORTING AN APPLICATION FOR TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM
FUNDS FOR CDOT FISCAL YEARS 2009, 2010 AND 2011.**

RECITALS

WHEREAS the Colorado Department of Transportation has requested applications for local government Enhancement Projects for CDOT Fiscal Years 2009, 2010 and 2011; and

WHEREAS the Town of Basalt has several projects which may qualify for Enhancement Funds and for which it is desirous of obtaining grant assistance; and

WHEREAS the first project, a Midland Avenue bicycle and pedestrian underpass across Highway 82, is identified in the Town of Basalt Master Plan as a high priority improvement; and

WHEREAS the second project, replacement of the existing Emma bridge over the Roaring Fork River which serves bicyclists and pedestrians, is a recommended short-term improvement in the Town of Basalt Master Plan; and

WHEREAS the third project, the addition of bicycle lanes and striping on Two Rivers Road between Midland Avenue and the downvalley Highway 82 intersection, is a recommended short-term improvement in the Town of Basalt Master Plan and is a component of the Two Rivers Greenway Master Plan adopted by the Town; and

WHEREAS the Town of Basalt has or will have sufficient local revenue sources to meet the required 20% minimum local match to support the projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Town Council of the Town of Basalt, Colorado, that:

1. The Town Council supports the application to the Colorado Department of Transportation for Enhancement Program funding for CDOT fiscal years 2009, 2010 and 2011 for any or all of the following three projects: the Midland Avenue bicycle and pedestrian underpass across Highway 82, the replacement of the existing Emma Bridge for bicycle and pedestrian use, and the addition of bicycle lanes and striping on Two Rivers Road.
