**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF BASALT, COLORADO,
SUPPORTING AN APPLICATION FOR TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM
FUNDS FOR CDOT FISCAL YEARS 2012, 2013 AND 2014.**

RECITALS

WHEREAS the Colorado Department of Transportation has requested applications for local government Enhancement Projects for CDOT Fiscal Years 2012, 2013 and 2014, and

WHEREAS the Town of Basalt has several projects which may qualify for Enhancement Funds and for which it is desirous of obtaining grant assistance, and

WHEREAS the highest priority project is a grade-separated bicycle and pedestrian crossing (overpass or underpass) across Highway 82 in the area from Basalt Avenue to Midland Avenue, and

WHEREAS this project is identified in the Town of Basalt Master Plan as a high priority improvement, and

WHEREAS the Town of Basalt has or will have sufficient local revenue sources to meet the required 20% minimum local match to support the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Town Council of the Town of Basalt, Colorado, that:

1. The Town Council supports the application to the Colorado Department of Transportation for Enhancement Program funding for CDOT fiscal years 2012, 2013 and 2014 for a grade-separated bicycle and pedestrian crossing of Highway 82 in the area from Basalt Avenue to Midland Avenue.
